Comments: A conversation was had with the administrator, who indicates that the operator has submitted an exemption request, as an educator's Early Childhood Education certificate is not on the list of educational institutions with recognized ECE programs. Comments: A transportation consent has been created by the Operator in order to obtain permission to transport the children to and from school using the facility's vehicles. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the renewal inspection, Inspector observed that the walls of a closet where Legos are stored are damaged. During the follow-up inspection, Inspector observed that the walls were repaired. However, there is a part of the left hand-wall that has yet to be repaired. Operator must ensure that this is done, in order to ensure that the indoor play area is maintained safe and clean.			
36(6) A cot, a nap mat or the mattress of a crib or portable playpen shall be washable and non-absorbent or covered with a non-absorbent layer.	36(6)	Apr 24, 2024	
Comments: Inspector observed that 2 rest mats are ripped at the edges. Operator must ensure that these are replaced in order to ensure that all rest mats are washable and non-absorbent.			
38(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide one potty chair or training seat for each group of three children who are being toilet-trained.	38(3)	Apr 10, 2024	May 01, 2024
Comments: The potty training seats are not stored on the floor. Deficiency is now compliant
