The administrator must ensure that all toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children. The administrator promptly removed the shaving cream and secured it in a locked area.

During the monitoring inspection, it was observed that although the toxic products were locked, the top drawers flipped down, allowing potential access to the toxic products by a child. The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed this with the administrator and recommended adding a clip or securing the drawers with glue to prevent access.

During the monitoring inspection, the following activities were observed: transition from school, transition to snack, Christmas tree art, Christmas ornament making, transition to outdoor play, and departures.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current and that all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.
