General Comments							
Monitoring inspection completed. Upon arrival all children and educators were playing in their designated rooms. Children were not observed in outdoor play today, however during previous visits, children always have outdoor play opportunities. It was a cold morning and hence the reason children remained indoors today. All educators provided a variety of indoor play activities that incorporated gross motor opportunities. Licensing staff observed children rolling snowballs back and forth to their friends, crawling in and out of a canvas tunnel, playing with musical toys and experimenting with other sounds, exploring different materials - soft and colored blocks including painting creations - snowflakes and winterwear painting activity using marshmallows and playing sleeping bunnies. Children were observed giggling, laughing, talking, playing cooperatively and squealing with excitement as staff engaged positively with the children. Appropriate child guidance observed, and staff provide appropriated supervision and involve children by asking them the choose colors they want to use in painting and provide gentle reminders about clean up. Child's attendance documented, new staff info was reviewed, incident reports completed and signed off by parents, infant toddler records completed daily, 15 minute naptime checks, and cleaning schedules are tracked. All children observed having a naptime and quiet gentle music was played.
