## General Comments

Positive child guidance was observed such has gentle reminders. One staff was observed consoling a child when he was crying. The staff were observed using gentle tones with the children. The environment is clean, organized and welcoming.

The toddler room table is chipping and needs a new coat of paint to ensure it can be properly sanitized.

We recommend using the updated child profiles and consent forms moving forward.

The lawn is also getting high on the back part of the playground and would need to be mowed.

We also observed the staff outside standing and talking among each other. Even outside, staff should be

engaged with children and playing with them. At one point ther infants, playing in the black tunnel and near the fence and ther the opening of the playground area.
