Comments: A support worker/relief person does not hold a first aid certificate and a CPR certificate. The person is enrolled for the course starting October 14, 2022. In the meantime, the administrator confirms that the person is not left alone with children. Also, the First Aid/CPR certificate of a person doing pick-ups is expired. The administrator confirms that the person is enrolled to do the course shortly and is not left alone with children as well.

Comments: In the preschool room, a locked cabinet wasn't locked during the renewal inspection. Tylenol caplets bottle was in the unlocked cabinet. Inspector asked the educator to lock the cabinet and reminded educators that the cabinet should always be locked to ensure that children do not have access to medications. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: An educator came in with a Tim Horton's coffee cup in the preschool room. Inspector informed the educator that hot beverages are not permitted in the classrooms. The educator expressed not being aware of this and threw the coffee cup in the garbage.  An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit hot beverages in areas that are occupied by the children receiving services at the licensed facility, including the outdoor play area.  Any hot beverages, even those in mugs with secured covers, are not permitted in play areas.  Deficiency is now compliant.			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Oct 19, 2022	
Comments: 2 child files on 12 child files verified did not have the immunization records or a copy of the exemption.  As stated in the Licensing Regulation – Early Childhood Services Act:  47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulation under that Act is not provided.  47(2) Subsection (1) does not apply if a child's parent or guardian provides one of the following documents: (a) a medical exemption, on a form provided by the Minister of Health, signed by a medical practitioner; or  (b) a written statement, signed by the parent or guardian, of the parent or guardian's objection for reasons of conscience or religious belief to the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act, on a form provided by the Minister of Health.			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, children were observed singing songs with the educators and they made paintings. In the morning preschool children did not have outdoor play as they had an organized activity to play on the inflatable. Administrator and educators confirmed that children were going to go outside later in the afternoon.</p> <p>Inspector discussed with both the administrator and educators regarding supervision of the children while using the washroom as children were seen leaving the classroom alone to meet an educator at the washroom. Inspector informed the administrator that children should always be with an educator when leaving the classroom. Inspector suggested that educators can bring a few children along while going to the washroom as children can be easily distracted if not always supervised.</p> <p>Inspector reminded the administrator to always have the kitchen/staff room closed and locked for safety reasons as that is where they are storing toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies. EpiPens are stored in a locked cabinet. Inspector asked for the EpiPens not to be locked as it should be easily accessible but out of the reach of the children. The educator put the EpiPens in the First Aid Kit and informed</p>
