Comments: During the follow-up inspection, inspector observed 3 preschool children at their cubby outside the preschool classroom with the door closed without any educators present supervising. Inspector informed educators that they must always supervise the children and recommended that an educator stands in the doorway to keep an eye on the children going to their cubby. Inspector asked for an educator to come supervise the children outside the classroom. Deficiency is now compliant.
