Comments: When Quality Assurance Monitor arrived in the classroom, she found a bottle of Tylenol in a cabinet that was accessible to children. Also, in the administrator's office, the cabinet with all the medications was not locked nor the office door. Medications need to be locked and inaccessible to children. An educator took the bottle of Tylenol out of the classroom, and the administrator immediately locked the medication storage space. Deficiency is now compliant

The facility implements an inclusive daily program which contains a variety of purposely planned activities, opportunities and experiences.

While Quality Assurance monitor was on site, she was able to observe story time and free indoor play. Educators facilitate children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end question.

QA monitor was also able to observe the kids play in the field of the dome. The kids were running, playing together with a large, inflated ball and having alot of fun.
