On the sink cabinet, the inspector observed a container of Lysol wipes. The wipes were immediately put inside the locked cabinet. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: The inspector observed 2 cups of Tim Hortons inside the classroom with children present. Hot Beverages are not permitted in area occupied by children. The educator immediately disposes of the coffee. Deficiency is now compliant
