Comments: In the preschool classroom, 8 children were present, but 10 children were signed in on the attendance sheet. The attendance records must be completed each time a child arrives and leaves, must be accurate and reflect all children present at any given time. The educator immediately signed out the children and the attendance sheet was accurate.							
For the school age group, the attendance sheet that the educators carried with them was not accurate and did not reflect all children present. More children were present than indicated on the children's attendance sheet. The educators and the administrator informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that another attendance sheet ( of a group whose educator was absent that day) was at the reception. All attendance sheet must follow the educator who is responsible for the children. The administrator combined all attendance sheet, and the clip board was brought into the classroom.
