General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a follow-up inspection. She is following-up on the following:

- Child to staff ratio

- Daily routine

- Indoor play area material and equipment

On April 1, 2024, the Quality Assurance was informed that the operator uses 6 vehicles for their transportation service. Only one motor vehicle insurance (for one vehicle) was sent with the renewal application. That being said, the 6 vehicles were not verified during the last renewal inspection.

After being requested by the QAM, all other motor vehicle insurances were sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor on April 4, 2024.

During this monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following elements for the 4 vehicles used for transportation, that were on site that day:

- If drivers and vehicles are in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act
- If emergency contacts for each child are present in each vehicle
- If a first aid kit is present in each vehicle

The 2 remaining vehicles were not on site at the time of the inspection.
