Comments: Inspector observed that daily activities on a calendar weekly was conducted. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Oct 03, 2024	
Comments: While walking to the facility, the inspector observed children's playing on the other side of the dome, away from the entrance area. However, the inspector observed three children on the sidewalk. During the last renewal inspection, a plan had been established for the children to play across street. However, due to sanitary concerns, the administrator did not allow them to play there today. Operator must ensure the outdoor play area is safe and secure for the children and that they play in their designated area. The inspector questioned the administrator and staff members about proper supervision practices and how they will ensure the children's safety. A backup plan must be in place for when geese are in the field across.			
33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Oct 03, 2024	
Comments: The inspector did not observe enough toys for the school-age children to play outside. Children must always have access to toys when outside.
