Comments: Pure essential oils and an aerosol deodorant were observed in a cupboard up high, out of reach. The educator stored these in the locked cupboard of cleaning supplies and toxic products during the inspection.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>I attended the centre for their license renewal inspection. The children were engaging in free play when I arrived. They had a wide range of organized centres of activities available including blocks, dress up, books, and arts and crafts. Educators got down on the children's level and engaged in activities with them.</p> <p>Educators prompted the children to clean their hands and prepare for snack. They then prepared for outdoor play. Educators encouraged children to prepare independently as much as possible but were available to support them when needed. Educators and their director worked well together to smooth out the transition periods to go outdoors.</p> <p>While outside educators chose good lines of sight and engaged with the children's play outdoors which included sandbox play, a mud kitchen, an art centre, and loose wood materials which the children used to balance on or to add to their play. Educators gave the children space to resolve minor conflicts when appropriate but also stepped in to comfort and redirect children when needed.</p> <p>Pending their annual fire and health inspections I recommend this license for renewal.</p>
