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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>The afterschool program has added a non-designated preschool program to their license. Upon licensing's arrival they were playing with a variety of materials and set up invitations. They use the smaller of the afterschool rooms for their classroom and it is very well arranged for this age group, bright and inviting with its own bathroom. Some of the invitations observed today were a flower shop with vases and fake flowers, a variety of blocks, lego, dinosaurs, arts and craft supplies and a reading corner with a carpet and books. Today's book choice was "Who Would Win" and it explored conflict between different animals such as different types of ants and lobsters versus crabs. The children were very engaged, and it sparked critical discussion between the children and their educator. Their bulletin board featuring drip art was beautiful to observe but also a great example of process art. This program ends everyday at noon with outside play and an outdoor pick up. The program closes in June, and the afterschool runs summer programs for afterschool only.</p> <p>The afterschool program arrived around 3 pm and everyone played outside. Heavy rain is forecast for tomorrow so the group was maximizing their outdoor play time as it may not be possible tomorrow. They use the Henry Park playground and there are swings, climbers, basketball nets, a fenced in area the children call the pit to play Ga Ga ball in and in the summer access to the public pool. They bring out a wagon which contained chalk, badminton racquets and birdies, skipping ropes and balls.</p> <p>The larger afterschool classroom has a space for gross motor activities, and they enjoy building large structures there or dancing. It has a couch, pillows and chairs for socializing. This room was well equipped with arts and craft supplies, dinosaurs, different types of blocks, books, games, barbies, racing cars and track etc.</p> <p>Licensing staff reviewed 5 staff files and 9 child files and found everything to be complete. The center is clean, organized and has a pleasant, relaxed atmosphere. The children and staff converse pleasantly with respectful, calm and patient interactions. There were no child guidance issues on the day of my visit.</p> |
