Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including open-ended art, a snow sensory opportunity, Christmas tree decorating, board games and dramatic play. Purposeful planning in evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to environment that support children's current interests (vet, dogs, Christmas and art).

Educators observed greeting each child at arrival and welcoming them to the after-school program.

QAM recommended adding a binder of documentation and photos to the indoor play area for children to revisit their experiences and learning.

Clementines and crackers were served for snack.

Handwashing routines observed before snack and after sensory play.

Daily attendance forms were completed as the children arrived and departed.

Monthly fire drills are documented.
