General Comments
A renewal inspection was conducted on August 14, 2026. All children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments. The indoor environment was well-equipped with a variety of materials and activities that encouraged children's engagement and play. Upon arrival, children were outdoors on the playground. They were observed using the swing set, playing tag, and engaging in active play with their peers and educators. When children transitioned indoors, materials had been thoughtfully arranged in the gymnasium to support a smooth transition. Activities available included a dollhouse with accessories, bean bag toss, a tote of badminton equipment, balls, and balance balls. Additional learning opportunities were available in the front area, which was set up with art materials and a cozy corner for quiet play and relaxation. Children were also observed eating snacks and lunches brought from home.

General Comments

All staff files were reviewed during the inspection. It was determined that one relief staff member who was filling in for the day did not have a completed Social Development Check on file. The staff member was sent from the location and will not return as staff in ratio until the required check has been completed. Licensing is to be updated once the Social Development Check has been received. A random review of 5 children's files was observed and complete.

A discussion was also held regarding employees under the age of 19. Staff under 19 years of age must be supervised at all times when working with children, regardless of whether all required checks and documentation have been completed.

At the time of the inspection, one educator was supervising 13 children, and an additional staff member had been temporarily assigned from another location to provide support.

All fire drills had been completed and documented appropriately. The parent information board was reviewed and found to be current and compliant with licensing requirements.
