| Comments: Attendance records must accompany the educator and children when they leave their room. One group uses a different room to nap in, however the educator did not take the attendance records with them. This was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant | | | |
| 28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act. | 28(3)(a) | Dec 14, 2020 | |
| Comments: Garbage cans in the diaper changing area must be equipped with a lid and lined with a plastic bag. Two cans do not have lids and one can is not lined with a plastic bag. Children's bedding must be kept separate in order to prevent the spread of germs. One educator was carrying several children's bedding in her arms to the nap room, all bedding was jumbled up together. | | | |
| 30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children. | 30(3) | Dec 11, 2020 | Dec 11, 2020 |
| Comments: An electrical outlet did not have a protective receptacle cover. All electrical outlets must have a plug cover installed. Was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant | | | |

| Comments: Several plastic structures are cracked, sharp edges present. Some exposed screws on wooden play materials. Some plastic toys are cracked and have sharp edges. All broken or hazardous equipment must be disposed of/replaced or repaired. | | | |

| Comments: Playground checklist has not been completed since August 2020. Must be completed monthly. | | | |
| 36(4) The rest area of a full-time early learning and childcare centre and an early learning and childcare home shall allow for a space of at least 46 cm between each crib, portable playpen, cot or nap mat. | 36(4) | Dec 11, 2020 | Dec 11, 2020 |
| Comments: In one room, two mats were placed less than 46 cm apart. Was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant | | | |
| 39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; | 39(2)(a) | Dec 11, 2020 | Dec 11, 2020 |
| Comments: An open bottle of Vim cleaner was in an unlocked cupboard. An air freshener spray was in an unlocked cupboard. Items were removed during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant. | | | |
| 44 An operator of a licensed facility shall have a first aid kit that is equipped with the contents prescribed by New Brunswick Regulation 2004-130 under the Occupational Health and Safety Act as a first aid kit that is not a personal, Type P first aid kit, and a telephone in working order (a) on the premises of the licensed facility. | 44(a) | Dec 18, 2020 | |
| Comments: One of the audited kits was not fully provisioned, some items need to be replenished. Administrator will check kit and restock all missing items. | | | |
| 48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (b) ensure that an infant who is bottle-fed is not fed in a crib. | 48(4)(b) | Dec 11, 2020 | Dec 11, 2020 |
| Comments: Two children were drinking from bottles while laying down on their nap mats. This is not permitted for any age of child. This was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant | | | |
| 48(5) If more than one bottle-fed infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall ensure that each bottle is (a) labelled with the child's name, (b) used only for the intended child. | 48(5) | Dec 14, 2020 | |
| Comments: Two bottles were not labelled, all bottles must be labelled. | | | |
