Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector was advised by the administrator that their vehicle is currently being repaired at the auto repair shop. The vehicle must be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act before it can be used to transport children.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that activities are purposely planned and documented in all classrooms. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the administrator and all educators have a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the roof of the outdoor shelter had been repaired. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the monthly review and maintenance plan is completed. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that infant bottles are now stored in the fridge. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Nov 21, 2022	Nov 21, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed a child walking from the bathroom to their classroom unsupervised. The operator must ensure that child-to-staff ratio is maintained at all times in the same age group. The administrator immediately addressed the situation with the educator. Deficiency is now compliant.			

#### General Comments

During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed a painting activity and outdoor play.

The inspector had a discussion with the operator and administrator about the importance of serving meals at meals times in order to ensure that children have enough food to last the entire day. The inspector suggested serving an extra snack to children who are hungry prior to lunch time.
