General Comments

Name of operator

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. Child-to-staff ratios were maintained throughout the visit.

The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following areas:

- -Washrooms
- -Storage spaces
- -Nutrition
- -Outdoor play area
- -Outdoor play area materials and equipment

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children engaged in various activities, including indoor play, outdoor play, and experimenting with "fake snow."

A discussion took place between the operator and the Quality Assurance Monitor regarding two classrooms that did not go outdoors during the visit. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that two out of five classrooms did not participate in outdoor play. The operator and administrator were reminded of Regulation 22, which states: The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include (a) outdoor play for at least one hour in each four-hour block

of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance, except in the following circumstances:

- (i) The wind chill is below -20°C
- (ii) The temperature is below -20°C
- (iii) The temperature is 33°C with humidity or above

The operator explained that each classroom has a scheduled outdoor play time and that educators are aware of their designated times. The Quality Assurance Monitor noted that educators had indicated their outdoor time was at 10:00 a.m.; however, it was well past that time and the group had not yet gone outside. The operator stated that a discussion would take place with educators to address this.

Another discussion occurred regarding a staff member whose Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Check has been expired since July. The operator stated that the staff member has been on vacation since September and is scheduled to return at the beginning of December. The Quality Assurance Monitor emphasized that the check should have been renewed immediately upon expiry. The operator confirmed that the staff member had been contacted and indicated they had completed a check in 2023 but was unsure why it was not in their file. The Quality Assurance Monitor reiterated that the updated Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Check must be completed before the staff member returns on site. The operator confirmed this will be done prior to the staff member's return.
