Comments: The daily routine posted are for the half-day routine. A full-day routine must be posted to reflect the child's time at the facility.

Comments: In the classroom with the loft, there were holes in the wall under the loft. There was also a hole in a wall of the second classroom. The holes need to be patched and painted.

<p>Comments: In the room with the loft, a toy bin containing blocks and a Beyblade arena are broken and have sharp edged. Must be disposed of/ be replaced. Two side railing on the loft are loose and must be repaired immediately. A section of the carpet is missing and must be replaced as it covers the bolts. In the second classroom, a blue armchair had tears that must be covered with a non-absorbent and easily cleanable surface.</p>			
<p>33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	33(1)	Mar 09, 2022	
<p>Comments: 2 groups of children were observed playing outside. Some items were brought out for the children to use like bubbles and hula hoops but the quantity was insufficient for the amount of children present.</p>			
<p>40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.</p>	40(1)(a)	Mar 09, 2022	
<p>Comments: Several water bottles were spotted in the classroom with no labels. All personal belonging must be labeled with the name of the child.</p>			

General Comments

The QAM observed the children during outside play. Supervision was lacking at certain times. A staff member was tending to a small group of children who were resolving a conflict. The other two educators were talking with their backs against a group of children and no one was observing the children playing on the hill, The operator should form a supervision plan to ensure proper supervision of children are met at all time.
