| Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the motor vehicle inspection sticker was expired. The operator shall ensure that the bus is in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act before transporting children. | | | |

The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file. | | | |
| 27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (j) permitting photographs and videos to be taken of the child for publication or social media. | 27(j) | Nov 07, 2022 | |
| Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication or social media was missing in 1 of the 8 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent from the parents is documented for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication or social media. | | | |

| Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 4 out of 5 water bottles brought from home were not labelled with the child's name. The operator must ensure that personal belongings brought into the facility are labelled with the name of the child. | | | |

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed outdoor free play, a Halloween craft activity, a purposely planned poppy drawing activity for Remembrance Day and snack time.
