Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 1 of the 8 employees does not have a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate. The operator must ensure that the employee receives a first aid (FA) certificate and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) level C certificate.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (iv) a signed declaration confirming that the staff member has read and understood his or her obligations under the Act and this Regulation.	24(1)(c)(iv)	Jan 09, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the staff signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation was missing in 1 or 8 staff files. The operator must ensure that a signed copy of the statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is maintained in the educator's file.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (vii) a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate for each administrator and educator.	24(1)(c)(vii)	Jan 27, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 1 of the 8 employees does not have a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate. The operator must ensure that the employee receives a first aid (FA) certificate and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) level C certificate.			
26(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall require the parent or guardian referred to in subsection (1) to sign a declaration confirming that he or she has read and understood the content of the handbook.	26(2)	Dec 08, 2022	Jan 05, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the signed statement from parents confirming they have read and understood the parent handbook is present in all 4 of the child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that consent for transporting the child or providing transportation is present in the 4 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (j) permitting photographs and videos to be taken of the child for publication or social media.	27(j)	Dec 08, 2022	Jan 05, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication on social media is present in the 4 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (k) posting photographs of the child at the licensed facility to illustrate the child's learning.	27(k)	Dec 08, 2022	Jan 05, 2023
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for posting photographs of child in the centre to illustrate learning is present in the 4 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jan 05, 2023	Jan 05, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed a bottle of Mr. Clean along with a gifted unopened bottle of wine on a shelf in the office. When the inspector arrived at the facility, the office door was opened, and the office was unattended. During the inspection, the operator removed the bottle of wine from the facility and confirmed with the inspector that the door will remain locked when the office is not occupied. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Dec 09, 2022	Jan 05, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 4 out of 5 water bottles are labelled with the name of the child. The operator advised the inspector that a reminder was sent to parents via social media advising them that personal belongings must be labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.
