Comments: 3 of the child cubby were not labelled with the child name. Each child personal space should be labelled with the child name to store their belongings separately from others.			
49(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that the guidance of the children receiving services at the licensed facility is positive and includes positive reinforcement, encouraging efforts and recognizing accomplishments.	49(1)	Aug 09, 2023	
Comments: In one classroom, the QA Monitor observed an educator ask the children to put away the toys as they were going to play a game. The children told the educator they didn't want to play the game. The educator answered she wasn't asking them that they need to put the toys away to play the game. It is important to take the time to understand the child's messages (cues) and to respond to them with the encouragement, praise, comfort and independence as needed. It is important to respect the children's feelings.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Monitoring inspection conducted. Ratio was respected during the visit.</p> <p>QA Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the roles of the Inclusion Support Workers and the educators. Some educators play the role of an ISW on some days.
