Comments: Kitchen door was open, unlocked. Must be kept locked when staff are not in the kitchen to supervise. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments

Strong smell of gasoline throughout the facility upon arrival, was apparently present all day. QA Monitor called Fire Inspector who came to facility and determined that the smell was from another tenant in the building. where some gasoline leaked from a generator overnight. The windows in the childcare facility were closed, most could not open as they had been screwed shut. The Operator had the screws removed and the windows were opened to air out the facility at 15:00.

QA Monitor called the Health Inspector for additional advice, when he arrived the smell had significantly dissipated. Operator will air out facility overnight and will contact QA Monitor when they reopen Friday morning to confirm that the air no longer smells of gasoline.

QA Monitor discussed with Administrator and Operator that in the future for any smell of gasoline that they must contact fire to ensure that the premises are safe for occupation, then can contact health for advice.
