Comments: The administrator informed the inspector that an email and a message via social media were sent to parents requiring them to label their child's personal belongings. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector observed that 5 out of 5 lunchboxes are labelled with the child's name. The administrator informed the inspector that an email and a message via social media were sent to parents requiring them to label their child's lunchbox. Deficiency is now compliant.
