<p>Comments: While arriving on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor notice 5 children playing in the gym without any supervision. The Quality Assurance Monitor was in the gym for a few minutes before going into the other room where an educator met the Quality Assurance Monitor at the entrance of the other room. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the educator concerning the children in the gym alone without any supervision. The educator stated that the educator would do check-ins on the children and walk back and forth from both rooms. The Quality Assurance Monitor mentioned the importance of the supervision in the gym as the stairs to go downstairs and outside are there and at any time a child could decide to leave the centre and if both educators were in the other room they would not notice. The educator decided to close the gym and all children were asked to go in the main room.</p> <p>While children were getting ready to go to the park, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that educators were looking for a specific child. The educators didn't know where the child was. The Quality Assurance Monitor heard an educator asking the other educator if the child was in the classroom. The educator proceeded to go look for the child in the main room. The educators called out the name of the child several times until the educators realized the child had made its way downstairs with no supervision. The child eventually came upstairs again and joined the rest of the group.</p> <p>Deficiency is now compliant.</p>
