The employee was contacted and instructed not to report for their scheduled shift until the required documentation is provided. The Operator is reminded that all employees must obtain and submit a Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check prior to commencing employment.

Comments: The Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection and observes that one EpiPen is stored in a locked cabinet within the kitchen area. The Educator promptly removes the medication and relocates it to a location that is both easily accessible in case of emergency and safely out of reach of children. Medications used for anaphylactic shock are stored safely but easily accessible at all times. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection. On this day, the center had set up an indoor haunted house in preparation for the children's arrival. Educators and volunteers were dressed in Halloween costumes, and the children eagerly awaited their turn to walk through the haunted house. Children were also observed engaging in indoor play activities, including basketball games, building tunnels with plastic connecting blocks, and constructing various creations with LEGO bricks.
