General Comments

Renewal inspection was completed today. The children were observed indoors only, as there was a thunder/lightning storm today. Lunch time and rest time routines were observed. Handwashing routines were also observed. Staff were noted to be sitting with the children during lunch time and engaging in conversation about the storm outside.

The children were noted to be interested in dress up today, trying on a variety of costumes. Other children were noted to be interested in birds and asking questions about this topic.

Only one hand soap dispenser accessible within preschool washroom today but there are 2 sinks. Please add another soap.

Pretend grapes had come off the vine within the pretend play area and were noted to be loose within the food bin. These are too small to be used by children under 3 years of age. Discussed with operator and these were removed. There was also a spice bottle container within the dramatic play area that had broken life saver candies inside. Requested that staff remove this bottle as well as this could be a potential choking hazard as well.

Allergies were posted within the preschool area and easily accessible along with emergency plans. EpiPen and Benadryl on site is expired. Parent /Guardian to be informed.

There was confusion over whether an EpiPen was or was not required for another child today and if there should be an EpiPen on site. An Allergy management plan was completed for this child in June 2022. This must be confirmed with the parent immediately and the child profile and Allergy Management Plan document should be updated to reflect current plan. All staff must be well informed of allergies and protocols to be taken.

CPR/First aid certification was discussed with staff. This will be expiring in October for many of the staff. Advised that this must be completed in order for staff to be left alone with children.

New backyard play equipment was noted on site today within the children's play areas. Operator must have a copy of the manufacturer's manual on site and ensure that all safety requirements are met.
