<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including dramatic play, puzzles, art, stories and exploring letters. The infants went for a neighborhood walk to get some fresh air in the wagon. The two/threes were exploring letters with their educator; they collected different letters to spell their names. The preschool group were observed exploring their environment freely; some "baked cupcakes" in the pretend kitchen and a few children explored print making with corks in paint.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (bugs, tractors, letters, police/careers, and pond). Educators have created a "Very Hungry Caterpillar" small world on the Tuff Tray; the children can explore elements of the story through loose parts, sensory materials and props.</p> <p>Handwashing was observed during washroom routines. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (3/6) requirement.</p>
