Comments: At the time of the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a bottle of rubbing Alcohol in an easily accessible place in the facility. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The administrator immediately stored the toxic product in the storage room. Deficiency is now compliant.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring inspection conducted. At the time of the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ratio and maximum number of children - Child records - Signed consent in child's file - Medication and records <p>New staff member was added into the system The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding children's access to toxic products, stored in the kitchen. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the storage space, containing toxic products and cleaning supplies inside the kitchen was unlocked. The administrator confirms that when parents provide medication, it is also stored in the kitchen. The door leading to the kitchen is locked, however, there is a large opening to the kitchen allowing children to enter and have access to toxic products and medication. At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor recommends locking the storage space.</p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe indoor play.</p>
