The inspector observed an educator reading Charlotte's web in one of the classrooms. The inspector also observed a sign language activity in another classroom.  During the inspection the ground was snow covered; therefore, the park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the licensing team. The use of the outdoor play structures is not recommended as the ground is frozen and does not provide protective surfacing.
