General Comments

The environments within each room are rich in materials to support learning opportunities for the children. The children were observed to be happily engaged in the interest centres throughout the rooms. Educators responsive to the children and have set up the learning environments based on the children's current interests.

Observation: Evidence of the children being familiar and comfortable with the daily routine. Positive interactions observed between educators and children; educators engaged with the children at their level.

Evidence of purposeful program planning based on the interests of the children. Documentation varied and current.
