**General Comments**

Reminder that children transitioning to a new room are included in the new group by gradually increasing the length of time until the transition is complete. (section 8.1.2)

Ensure that checks on sleeping infants under 15 months of age are documented with staff signatures and the times of the check (Every 15 minutes).  
 Moving forward to ensure that children are appropriately supervised ratio must be maintained at all times (even nap time) for children under than 15 months of age. (section 8.1.4).

Be sure dry erase boards outside of each room are kept up to date for parents.

Ensure children's full names are added to the daily incident logs.

Environments are bright and welcoming with materials set up for the interests of the children and their current learning.  
 Photos of children's families are displayed at their level and demonstrate the value of the family and the important relationship between the centre and home.

A wide range of current documentation is posted throughout all learning environments.  
 Children actively exploring the interest centres and materials available at their level.  
 Educators observed to be engaged in play with the children.
