Indoor environments have an abundance of materials available to invite children's engagement. Invitations to learning were observed set up to invite children's exploration and curiosity. Purposefully planned invitations like this value children's interests and can extend and expand children's learning as well as provoke a new interest.							
Documentary evidence of children's learning posted throughout all environments. Webs, learning stories, photos, art work and children's words and mark making were all evident today. Administrator shared that educators are being encouraged to try new forms of documentation.							
Educators were observed encouraging and supporting children's efforts as they prepared for outdoor play, engaging with them in conversation about activities they could do and what they might see in the outdoor environment.
