Comments: Room 6: Amoxicillin administered: Missing parent/guardian signature on form. Recommending going forward that if parents are not entering the Early Learning Centre that a clip board be kept at the entryway and when educators/administrators gather the child from the parent and the parent gives them medication for their child that the form be filled out then. Discussed with educators in the room as well at Team Leader at time of inspection.

Comments: Room 1: Handwashing did not occur after outside play. Discussed with educators in the room. Room 5: Handwashing did not occur after diaper changing. Discussed with educators in the room. Room 1: Paint touchups required on wall beneath wooden bulletin boards, as well as wall between learning environment and sleep/nap room. Corner wall by window cracked, to be repaired. Room 2: Paint touch-ups required on wall beneath window as well as wall dividing Room 2 and Room 3. Room 3: Wall beneath bulletin board by bookcase, paint touch-ups required as well on the Room 3 side of the dividing wall. Room 5: Paint touch-ups required on walls. Room 6: Large bulletin board on right had wall entering room has loose screws and needs to be remounted on the wall.

General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection was conducted today. The children were observed during inside and outside play, lunch and rest/nap time.</p> <p>In all rooms the children's learning is displayed and documented with their learning experiences. The children have been engaged in learning about sounds, farm animals, snow/snowmen, trucks/construction, senses, and winter in their individual learning environments.</p> <p>A variety of documentation in each room is displayed in the forms of pictures, learning stories, and art in individual and group activities.</p> <p>The educators were observed engaged with the children, down at their level in their learning and play. Educators were also observed singing with the children to help with transition times between activities and lunch.</p> <p>The children appeared happy and content in their environments and with their educators and the educators were observed having respectful and meaningful conversations with the children.</p>
