Comments: Room 4 - Glue was not accessible to the children. Room 5 - Glue and Scissors were not accessible to the children. Room 6A - Glue was not accessible to the children. Room 6 B - Scissors were not accessible to the children.  Glue and Scissors are to be accessible to the children. If either material is being misused, they can be kept in see through containers, with lids, in an area that is accessible to the children. By using see through containers with lids, children are able to show educators when they want to use these materials.

Comments: Room 5 - Loose soother observed on brown shelf, behind door. Soothers are to be stored in individual containers and labelled, with the child's name.			

General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed inside. Several forms of documentation were observed in each room. Positive child guidance techniques were also observed in each room - Educators understanding childhood development, educators offering choices, educators anticipating children's needs, and educators giving gentle reminders. Well defined learning and play centers were observed in each room.

Room 1 - Diaper Changing procedures were observed and followed. After diaper changes, children were observed getting ready for their snacks. Educator stated that the children are presently very interested in sensory play.

Room 2 - Children had just finished their snacks. An educator was observed reading a book to the children. After the book, educators were observed helping the children get ready for outside play.

Room 3 - Children had just finished their snacks and were observed helping their educator clean up, before getting ready to go outside. Educator stated that the children are presently very interested in the new dinosaur toy, and anything to do with animals.

Room 4 - Children and educators were outside.

Room 5 - Children were observed lining up, getting ready to go outside.

Room 6A (Smaller side) - Children were observed looking at books and preparing for outside play. Educator stated that the children are presently interested in cars, blocks, and puzzles.

Room 6B (Bigger side) - Children were observed finishing their snacks. Those who finished early, were observed looking at books. Children were also observed lining up, to go outside.
