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General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today, March 16, 2026.</p> <p>During the inspection, Inspector observed the children during transitions from inside to outside play, snack, handwashing, lunch and preparing for nap/quiet time. Transitions were observed occurring naturally and smoothly. Educators were observed giving the children verbal cues of an upcoming transition and allowing the children time to finish their play before moving to the next activity.</p> <p>Inspector observed the educators in all four learning environments on this license, down at the level of the children in their learning and play. Speaking appropriately to them and using positive child guidance techniques when redirecting children.</p> <p>Room 7: Inspector observed the children in this room having morning snack, indoor play with materials, preparing for outside and returning from outside play, lunch and transitioning to nap/quiet time. Inspector observed documentation on the walls of the children's current interests of Spring. A web was observed created out lining what the children will be exploring and learning. Pictures of the children creating with art with flowers was also observed.</p> <p>Room 8: Inspector observed the children during morning meeting, reading a story with the educators. Documentation on the walls depict the children current and past learning. Exploring the neighborhood, visiting the library, learning about neighborhood literacies by "reading" signs in the neighborhood. A picture of a local author reading to the children was also observed. The children are currently tracking how many books they have read since January 2026, and the educators indicated that have reached over two hundred books read to the children since then. This was observed documented and displayed within the learning environment.</p> <p>Room 9: Inspector observed that the children in this room have been learning about the author Mo Willems, author/illustrator of the Elephant and Piggie books. A chart on the wall with pictures of the books by the author was observed and the educators have recorded the children's favorite books by this author. Pictures of the children creating art of their favorite characters from these books was displayed. Inspector also observed that the children are currently interested in building/construction. Documentation on the walls show the children</p>

building and creating with wooden blocks, sticks, dowels, strings, loose parts, and small structures.

Room 10: Children in this room were observed exploring at tuff tray that the educator had arranged with magnet tiles, tweezers, colored rice, letters, small bowls, and scoops. The children in this room are also exploring literacies with authors and illustrators of their favorite books. This was observed displayed on the wall of the learning environment. The educator indicated that the children had also been exploring tree rings to see how old trees were as well as learning about animal hibernation.

Recommending that in each of the learning environments a binder be placed for educators to keep their learning stories and documentation so that licensing can observed past learning of the children during inspections. Inspector discussed with Team Leader during the inspection.

Facility is recommended for license renewal.
