General Comments

Educators are continuously working hard to demonstrate pre planned programming and documentation. Licensing staff observed learning stories, pictures, webbing, and idea documentation. There was also evidence of open ended activities and children / teacher brainstorming in the facility.

There is now an updated file for the owner/operator. Administrator submitted their SD check to social development and confirmation was given that it has been received.

Administrator has purchased 3 complete first aid kits and has stated that these kits accompany educators on walks. Licensing staff stated that a full first aid kit only needs to accompany staff on outings away from the facility. Licensing staff advised administrator that the more common first aid kit items such as bandaids and cleanser should be brought to outside play area.

The allocation of space has been approved by the Department. However, please understand that should any changes be made without approval in the future, the space will have to meet all of the current regulations under
