Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a monitoring inspection on October 26th, 2022.

When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility, the children were finishing up their lunch and getting ready to have quiet/nap time.

On the day of the inspection, it was noted that the school-aged indoor play space had more space for the school-aged children to engage in play than the last monitoring inspection.

On the day of the monitoring inspection, it was noted that there were enough educators on site to maintain child-to-staff ratio and no need to put the inclusion support worker into the child-to-staff ratio in the afternoon when the school aged children arrive off the school bus.

The transition from lunch time to quiet time was a smooth transition. The educators put on some lullaby music on for the children during this time.
