It is my understanding the practice has been the potential illness form goes home with the parent at pick up. A copy of the completed form must be retained on site and must be signed by the parent prior to leaving and the time of pick up. The potential illness form provides parents instructions and their responsibility to notify the facility operator/administrator of details relating to the child's condition within 24 hours. Parents are responsible to advise the centre reasons for a child's absence especially in cases of illness. It is an Administrator's responsibility to report diseases and cluster of illnesses (an unusual number or greater than expected or normally seen) in children and staff that are ill with the same symptoms at the same time. Please advise when all potential illness forms have been returned and fully completed and stored in the child file for those children who left the centre ill. Please continue to post your illness notice so parents are aware.
