Comments: While QA monitor was on site, she heard the operator tell the children that they were not going outside today. When a child asked why, the operator tells him that they are busy indoors today. Outdoor play must occur at lease one hour in each four-hour block. Outdoor play is important to a child's healthy development. All children, including infants, are expected to play outside each day.
