Comments: Inspector is unable to see the programming of the daily activities for the month of April 2024. Operator must ensure that daily programming that reflects the children's interests is documented.

Comments: 1 of the audited children's records is missing the child's Medicare number. Operator must ensure that this information is added in the child's file.

Comments: 1 of the audited children's records is missing the full address of the medical practitioner. Operator must ensure that this information is added in the child's file.

<p>Comments: The daily routine for school days is posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. However, the routine for when the children spend a full day at the facility is not posted. Operator must ensure that this routine is posted.</p>			
<p>31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.</p>	31(3)	Apr 05, 2024	
<p>Comments: There is a broken pink sand bucket and a broken hula hoop in the outdoor play area. Operator must ensure that these are removed from the outdoor play area in order to ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazard.</p>			
<p>32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.</p>	32(1)(d)	Apr 09, 2024	
<p>Comments: A white 3 drawer storage cabinet in the indoor play area is broken, leaving sharp edges exposed. Operator must ensure that this is repaired or removed from the indoor play area, in order to ensure that the indoor play area material and equipment is in good repair.</p>			
<p>39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;</p>	39(2)(a)	Apr 02, 2024	Apr 02, 2024
<p>Comments: A bottle of Scrubbing Bubbles toilet cleaner is left in a cabinet underneath the bathroom sink, which is unlocked. All toxic products must be placed under lock and key. This was addressed with the Operator, who placed this under lock and key immediately. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, a conversation was had with the Operator regarding changes that must be to the parent handbook. Operator indicates that required changes will be made.</p> <p>Inspector observed empty pop bottles and other pieces of plastic in the outdoor play area. Inspector observed the Operator picking them up during the inspection. Operator indicates that as the snow melts, she is picking up the trash that was underneath the snow during the winter.</p> <p>A reminder to ensure that children wash their hands before eating.</p> <p>Ratio is respected during the time of the inspection.</p>
