General Comments

Today is a half school day for the children. When they arrived off the bus, two groups went inside while one group went to the outside play space to play before having lunch.

On Wednesday's, the facility offers their families with the ability to purchase a "hot lunch" which is purchased from different local vendors. Parents are provided with the "hot lunch" scheduled rotation of vendors. Today's hot lunch was pizza and garlic fingers from Jack's Pizza. Unfortunately, due to an unforeseen power outage in the downtown Fredericton area, lunch arrived a little later than usual. Educators were quick to act to have activities prepared and set out for the children to do while waiting for hot lunch to be delivered.

After lunch, the children were able to play freely around the room while they waited for the bus to arrive to bring them to O'Dell Park for their fieldtrip.

Educators assured all children were wearing their "Go-Go vests" before leaving to get on the bus. Observed educators taking roll call before getting on the bus and again once they reached their destination and were off the bus. Once they arrived at O'Dell, educators were handed a schedule with different activities they could do with the children. Some of these activities were a nature hike, playing at the park and sliding.

It is recommended to have the ends of the mat by the children's cubbies/entrance of the facility secured to the floor as one end is beginning to curl, creating a potential tripping hazard.

A reminder that when educators are counted in ratio, they are to be supervising and interacting with the children. Observed one educator sitting on a chair cleaning books with minimal interaction with the children at time of inspection, while the second educator was tending to the large group of children. Administrator addressed the situation at time of inspection and educator actively rejoined the group.
