General Comments

Upon arrival at the facility, the children were engaged in free play activities such as playing in the dramatic play kitchen, playing with building blocks, dolls and Pokémon cards. The educators were observed cleaning and playing with the children.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The children's personal belongings in the back room were not properly stored upon licensing staff's arrival but were re-organized during the monitoring inspection. There were pictures of the children playing and engaging in multiple activities displayed in the classrooms. There were age-appropriate books in the "cozy corner" and various arts and crafts materials located at an accessible height for the children to reach.

Once it was time to transition, the educators asked the children to use the washroom and get ready to go outside. The children put on their outdoor shoes, hats and filled up their water bottles. Before going outside, a head count was completed by the educator. They then brought a first aid bag and attendance sheet outside. While outside, the children engaged in free play activities such as playing on the play structures, playing in the sand box and digging in the gravel. Other children decided to make bracelets and art with bingo dabbers at a few picnic tables.

The educators were observed encouraging the children to apply sunscreen as it was a nice sunny day. The children agreed and applied sunscreen. As some children did not want to apply sunscreen, one educator was heard explaining the importance of sunscreen. The child agreed and the educator was observed giving the child their sunscreen. The educators were heard encouraging the children to remain safe on the larger play structures.

Upon returning inside for lunch, the children washed their hands and sat down at the lunch tables. The children were observed eating at the lunch table while the educators helped them open lunch containers. When a conflict occurred over candy, the educator was observed asking the children who's candy it belonged to and returned the candy to the child's lunch box. After lunch, the children engaged in free play activities such as playing with magnetic blocks, Pokémon cards, coloring, drawing and reading. The educators set out an invitation to play for the children on a separate table for the children to engage with if they chose to.
