Comments: While licensing staff were observing the outdoor play area, it was noted that the toy storage bin had materials, but did not have a sufficient amount for 27 school age children. Licensing staff recommends supplying more hockey sticks, chalk, soccer and basket balls, frisbees, etc. Licensing staff also recommends bringing materials over the fence back into the designated area.			

General Comments
<p>Upon the arrival of licensing staff, some children were observed eating lunch, while those who had finished engaged in various activities such as playing with hockey sticks, reading books, playing in the dramatic play area, and some were drawing. All materials provided were age appropriate, and there was an abundance. Once the group had completed their meals, educators guided the children in cleaning up and preparing for an outing to "Good Guys Golf." Educators were also seen cleaning the tables during this time.</p> <p>While waiting for the bus to arrive, an educator engaged the entire group in a calm and inclusive game. Educators ensured that both the first aid kit and a telephone were brought along for the trip. Previous activities were displayed on the bulletin board, including one that showcased a creative recycling project.</p> <p>Upon returning to the center from their outing, educators were observed taking attendance as the children waited in a single-file line before entering the daycare. Once inside, the children changed their shoes in preparation to enjoy a snack outdoors, followed by outdoor play for the remainder of the day.</p>
