## **General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed early learning and childcare home while the children were engaging in outdoor play. The children were observed building in the construction area, racing on the lawn to see if they could beat their personal best time.

The operator and children took licensing staff through the paths in the woods that the operator created for the children to explore and collect natural materials from the forest. The children also fed and checked on the worms in their worm farm. The worm farm was still cool and enough moisture for the worms to thrive.

The children help the operator clear an area of debris with shovels and wheel barrel before going indoors to do a creative art activity that was purposely planned by the operator. The children traced and drew their own bugs on the paper provided by the operator.

While the children were creating, the operator showed me multiple scrap books filled with evidence of learning. Licensing staff also noted multiple drawings, painting, learning stories, just to name a few, posted on the walls throughout the indoor learning environments. All evidence of learning was posted at the child's level as to revisit their learning experiences.

The operator and the children told licensing staff that they have been curios about bugs and showed licensing staff their butterfly chrysalis. The children have been tracking the growth by measuring the larva and observing any changes over time. The children observed the larva "wiggling" one day and thought it was time for the butterfly to emerge but then the larva stopped "wiggling' and are patiently waiting for the butterflies to emerge.

After the children finished creating their masterpieces they read two books, "Pete the Cat." and "Charlie the Caterpillar," and then washed up for lunch.

Licensing staff recommends the early learning and childcare home for their license renewal.
