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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the Early Learning and Childcare Home to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Today the Operator had one child in attendance. Upon arrival, the Operator and child were playing outside. There was a large variety of outdoor play materials, all in good condition. Trucks, cars, a push bike, a swing and a large sensory tray with play materials were readily available.</p> <p>Inside, the home was bright, welcoming and organized. Learning stories, artwork and pictures were displayed in the main entrance. Once hats, mittens, jackets and boots were removed, the Operator and child were observed washing their hands before entering the classroom. The Operator stated the child has a new art studio at their house and has been showing interest in creating artwork. A picture of a sun and a house were seen on a table nearby that the child had created earlier in the morning. Crafting and art materials such as markers, crayons, clay, scissors, paper and paint sticks were stationed on the table for easy access.</p> <p>Later in the morning the child was eager to lead the Operator and Licensing Staff through morning stretches before gathering together to read "Bears Best Friend". After the story, the child and Operator sat together for lunch. The Operator engaged in conversation as the child ate, offering assistance as needed. After lunch, the child prepared for nap time. The transition from lunch to nap was smooth. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. A conversation was had on site today with the Operator regarding adding a morning preschool program. Additional support documents will be sent to the Operator.</p>
