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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the early learning and child care home to conduct the annual license renewal inspection.</p> <p>Upon arrival, the operator and child were preparing to go outdoors to the outdoor play environment. The outdoor play space provided a rich and engaging natural learning environment that supported exploration, creativity, and imaginative play. Features included a fairy garden, a wooden storage area for art materials, a wooden playhouse, forest trails for exploration, and wooden bear and deer figures located throughout the wooded area. Additional outdoor play materials included plastic geese, rabbits, and birds that encouraged imaginative and nature-based play experiences.</p> <p>During the indoor portion of the inspection, the child engaged in playdough activities using a variety of accessories. The child enthusiastically created multiple flowers in different colours, including green and red, and proudly shared their creations with licensing staff.</p> <p>Prior to lunch, the child washed their hands before sitting at the table to eat lunch. Following the meal, licensing staff read two storybooks with the child before they prepared for their afternoon nap.</p> <p>A review of records indicated that all files were well organized, complete, and contained the necessary documentation.</p> <p>Throughout the inspection, the operator demonstrated positive child guidance practices and consistently interacted with the child in a respectful, supportive, and encouraging manner.</p> <p>Based on observations made during the inspection and the review of required documentation, licensing staff recommend the licensed early learning and child care home for license renewal.</p>
