The early childhood coordinator will be going for visits to bring support to the operator and director on creating zones and space to increase children's learning.
 -The entry way must be cleaned and declutter; the entranceway needs to be free in case of a fire.
 -The babies sleeping room must be tidy and in order the passage needs to be free in case of a fire.
 -Add a conversation with director on mixing the children and the importance of maintaining her COVID bubbles, daily logs are going to be re-established.
