I was screened. The facility is following the COVID-19 Recovery phase recommendations including a record of household members in each child's file, 5 hours temperature checks and group logs. Signage is visible in several areas of the building. There are two spaces for children with 2 educators in each room. The children were engaged in a variety of activities in each room. Centres are set up in each space with movement, building, art, and literacy. A science experiment with bread was set up in one room and the children and educators were involved in testing surface tension with bubbles and different items. In the second room, children were using plungers for different art pieces and trying different paints for pouring art. The programs would usually go outside in the afternoon due to the increased temperature and humidity, they are engaging in games and activities.
