General Comments

When Quality Assurance Monitor arrived for today's morning inspection, some children had already arrived from school and were playing freely around the round, while they waited for their friends to arrive. Some activities that children were observed partaking in is ringette, barbies and ponies, magnetic blocks, racetrack and dinky cars. When the other two groups of children arrived from school, educators ensure they all washed their hands before entering the classroom to play.

While children are permitted to play active games inside (they were playing a mixture of mini sticks hockey and ringette), educator was observed to be keeping a close eye of the game to ensure the children were playing safely.

Once all children had arrived and they were provided with ample opportunity to play freely, educator asked that they tidy up and meet her on the carpet. She then proceeded to explain that they were going to STEM activities. Educators put out an eye dropper/spray bottle table, a Marble maze/building area, clay creation table, Snap circuit table, and a table to make harmonicas. Children were observed moving freely from center to center and were seemingly enjoying each center, especially the table where they got create their very own harmonica to take home!

Facility has a nice comfy corner which consists of two large couches, several pillows, blankets, and a carpeted area. Observer an abundance of age-appropriate books that children were enjoying at time of visit.

All carpets appeared to be in great shape and clean at time on inspection.

All educator files observed today were found in be in compliance with Licensing Act and regulation.

Educators were observed happily participating in children's play. Quality Assurance Monitor heard an abundance of praise from the educators for children's accomplishments. You could hear lots of laughs and giggles from educators and children throughout the room during time of inspection.

It is recommended that monitoring visit reports and renewal inspection reports be posted separately (side by

side) in order for parents/guardians to easily view both reports. Even though the facility's last monitoring visit report was indeed posted, parents/guardians are unable to see it as it is kept in the same clear sleeve behind the renewal inspection report, which is held close by a tack to the parent/guardian information board. In order for parents/guardians to see both reports, they would have to remove the clear sleeve from the board and also remove the reports from the sleeve.
